



Plate CLXX from the third edition of

Visit to Grimsthorpe Castle, Bourne, Lincs, Tuesday 4th May 2010

A private visit has been arranged to this great Vanburgh house (on a day when visitors are not usually admitted). A seat of Lady Willoughby d'Eresby, Grimsthorpe has superb collections of works of art assembled by the Dukes of Ancaster and their descendants: paintings, tapestries, English and French furniture, including a remarkable series of royal thrones. The Chippendale furniture was inherited through a connection with the Heathcote family.

The visit will include a coach tour of the magnificent park with one of the guides joining us on the coach; a two course lunch; a private guided tour of the Castle and time to see the gardens.
