'Two Designs of Chairs for Gardens, and a long Seat. That marked A, is proper for Arbours, or Summer-Houfes, and C proper for Grottos; the seat marked B, may be placed in Walks, or at the Ends of Avenues. The Backs may be cut out from folid Board, and fixed to the Back Edges of the Seats...The length of Seat B is seven Feet.'
