We are extremely fortunate to have Mrs Robin Compton of Newby Hall as our guest speaker. Members will be aware of the outstanding collection of English furniture at Newby which includes many pieces made by Thomas Chippendale for the principle rooms designed by Robert Adam. One of the most celebrated interiors is the tapestry drawing room. Members will recall last year how fascinating it was to hear personal anecdotes from Lady St Oswald about living in a Chippendale house. Mrs Compton has initiated a brilliant programme of re-furbishment at Newby aimed to create authentic period interiors.

The price has once again been kept as low as possible, and the Committee very much hopes that as many members and their friends as possible will support what promises to be a glittering occasion. The caterers, who looked after us so well last year, have been booked once again.

Lastly, it is pleasant to record that the dinner this year falls on the very day - 5 June - that Chippendale was baptised 269 years ago.
